This is the expected running order, adjustments may need to be made depending on number of entered runs, or other considerations.

Judging will start no earlier than 8 a.m. each day—Your Final Confirmation and Trial Information, emailed after the close of the trial, will provide details on start times each day.

NOTE to avoid ring conflicts for Master Standard and JWW so that the same height is not running simultaneously in both rings, we will most likely shift the height running order for those classes in one of the rings.

Open and Novice FAST will walk together; and may run combined.

FEO is offered at this trial.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds

If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Effective 1/2/18, the 26-inch jump height division is replaced by the 24-Choice jump height division.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Jump height cards are not required to be submitted with the entry form. The jump height box on the entry form MUST be filled in. An estimated height at withers must be entered for all dogs, including those needing to be measured.

ENTERING A MIXTURE OF REGULAR AND PREFERRED CLASSES WITHIN THE SAME TRIAL WEEKEND –

MULTIPLE JUMP HEIGHTS WITHIN THE SAME TRIAL DAY

- **A separate entry form** must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.
- **Multiple Jump Heights:** Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20 inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Indoor, heated arena on packed dirt. 24" spaced weave poles; Rubber contacts, plastic jumps with single moveable jump-cups, displaceable tire, and electronic timers, (2) 100' x 100' rings.

WALK-THROUGHS AND Warm-Up INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only and will be limited to a maximum of 25 handlers. Handlers with multiple dogs/conflicts: Tell the gate-steward if you need to move your dog, they will help you manage your conflict.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RINGSIDE - Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

MOVE UP REQUESTS

Pre-trial Move ups must be sent in writing (e-mail is acceptable and preferred) to the Trial Secretary for **no later than Monday, May 11, by 6:00 PM**. Move ups from Friday to Saturday, Saturday to Sunday must be submitted on the move-up sheet at the trial, to the trial secretary **no later than 15 minutes after the last class** on Friday & Saturday.

BIS REFUND

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on the first day of the trials. (Friday May 15)

Injury/Illness – Injury/Illness – AKC does not require clubs to offer any refund for dogs that are pulled after closing for injury/illness. However, as a courtesy to our exhibitors CDCA offers a partial refund if a request for refund with required documentation is presented to trial secretary as defined here: Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be given a partial refund minus processing fees of \$8.00 per run in the form of vouchers to be used at future CDCA trials. A written vet letter (on office letterhead) must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on the first day of the trials (Friday May 15). (Letters from chiropractors and massage therapists are not valid) **Injuries/illness to handlers are excluded from this policy**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor. Dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement."
- Pinch collars, electric and dummy collars are prohibited on the trial grounds.
- Training/chain collars are 'choke' collars and they are allowed on the grounds.

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

FIX AND GO ON

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

**CANAAN DOG CLUB OF AMERICA
ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY**

Canaan Dog Club of America, Inc. has adopted the following rules in order to ensure that its members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels/campgrounds in the future.

Any individual attending a CDCA sanctioned event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairgrounds has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dog(s) on the grounds.

Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairground and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all of the following actions by the CDCA Board of Directors:

- 1 May be banned from showing at the next CDCA Sanctioned event(s).
- 2 May be subject to AKC sanctions.
- 3 Membership in CDCA may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated.

Damage shall be defined as:

- 1 Flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property (wall, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.).
- 2 Any verified complaint by the host hotel/campsite/fairground.
- 3 Any verified complaint by a CDCA Member.

CDCA Room Regulations:

- 1 All dogs shall be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with dog.
- 2 Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages.
- 3 No bathing or grooming will be allowed in rooms.
- 4 Dogs are to be allowed on hotel furniture/beds ONLY if the furniture is covered with protected covering provided by the owner/handler.
- 5 All owners/handlers will take preventive measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to their arriving at the hotel/campsite.
6. Protective sheeting shall be placed under all crates in hotels.

THIS POLICY IS INCLUDED IN INFORMATION AND/OR PREMIUM LISTS FOR ANY CDCA SPONSORED EVENT WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT SIGNING THE ENTRY FORM OR REGISTERING FOR THE EVENT ALSO INSURES COMPLIANCE WITH THIS POLICY.


