FEO RUNS (For exhibition only) ARE OFFERED AT THIS TRIAL.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds

Entries must be submitted on Official AKC-form with **correct** entry-fees listed and enclosed. One dog per form. **Please read the section: "Class changes effective January 1, 2020," posted in the premium, for instructions when entering same dog in multiple heights or mixed regular and preferred classes.**

Agreement on back of form MUST be signed. Photo-copies must be legible with original signature. Max 10 entries (dogs) per envelope (includes Express-mail-entries).

NO emailed forms, fax or telephone entries accepted.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.** Be sure to include correct fees. Overpayments less than \$10 will not be refunded

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 50% online each day, 50% paper entry each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

PLEASE NOTE:

Effective 1/2/18, the 26-inch jump height division is replaced by the 24-Choice jump height division.

RINGSIDE - Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2022

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring, or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor. Dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement."
- Pinch collars, electric and dummy collars are prohibited on the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Rubberized contacts will be used.

All classes will take place on groomed dirt.

Ring size will be a minimum of 95x90 square feet.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. No umbrellas allowed on course during walk-throughs.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

MOVE UP REQUESTS

Pre-trial Move ups must be sent in writing (e-mail is acceptable and preferred-- NO TEXTS OR INSTANT MESSAGES-- to the Trial Secretary **no later than Monday, June 1 2026, by 6:00 PM**. Move ups from Saturday to Sunday must be logged on the move-up sheet at the site no later than 15 minutes after the last class on Saturday, The trial secretary will be more than grateful if you will do your move-ups as soon as possible.

BIS, AND INJURY REFUND INFORMATION

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$4.50 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on Friday June 5, 2026.

Injury/Illness AKC does not require clubs to offer any refund for dogs that are pulled after closing for injury/illness. However, as a courtesy to our exhibitors MCKC offers a partial refund if a request for refund with required documentation is presented to the trial secretary as defined here: Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be given a partial refund minus processing fees of \$8.00 per run. A written vet letter (on office letterhead) must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on the first day of the trials (Friday, June 5, 2026). Letters from chiropractors and massage therapists are not valid. **Injuries/illness to handlers are excluded from this policy**

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

Directions: There are many ways to get to the site on various highways, your GPS may be the best guide.

Major routes: From I-85/I-40: Take Hwy 421 south,

- Take the Company Mill/Woody Mill exit (exit 194), turn left off ramp.
- At second light turn right on Liberty Rd, go approx 2 miles south on Liberty Road Turn left on Dona Rd. Go approx 2 miles on Dona Rd
- Turn left onto Old Julian.
- Clarence Rd is on the left approx ½ mile. Look for Quicksilver Canine sign.

- From south: Take Hwy 421 north,
- Take Hwy 62 exit (exit 190), turn left off ramp,
- Continue to first stop sign at Liberty Rd, turn right onto Liberty Rd,
- Take an immediate left onto Old Julian (there is a blinking light, if you pass the Gulf Station you went too far).
- Continue about 2 miles on Old Julian.
- Clarence Rd is on the left. Look for Quicksilver sign.

Clarence Rd is a gravel road, the training building is at the very end. Pass thru the white fence, past some residences and farm buildings, Continue to the end and you will see the facility, a blue metal building.

Please adhere to the posted speed limit on the gravel road!

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class.

- ❖ QUALIFYING ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.
- ❖ MACH/PACH Rosettes and a MACH/PACH bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH/PACH title at this trial.
- ❖ NEW TITLE ribbons will be given to dogs earning a new title.
- ❖ GRAND CHAMPION ribbon will be given to exhibitors earning a Grand Champion title at this trial.
- ❖ DOUBLE Q ribbons will be awarded to all dog and handler teams qualifying in required classes.

All ribbons must be claimed by the end of the Trial; none will be mailed.

CRATING OPTIONS

There is indoor crating available, however it is limited, so please crate in rows, and stack if you are able, to allow for the maximum number of indoor crating. There are some crates in the facility that you are welcome to use if they are empty. The empty, unlocked crates can be used, first-come, first-served, but please provide your own crate mat. Otherwise, there is also some room for personal crates. Please be prepared to adjust as it is determined where room is needed for walking space.

VOLUNTEERING AT THE TRIAL

We need your HELP for a Successful Trial!

Once again, we are counting on the generosity of agility enthusiasts to pitch in and help keep the trial running smoothly and efficiently.

Those of you who are experienced can help us by sharing your talents and helping to train the newcomers. For those of you who are new to agility, we will train you and offer support as you learn about what it takes to put on a trial.

We will have several raffle drawings during the day for our volunteers!

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

FEO will be offered at this trial. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all AKC classes offered. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time
- Maximum course time: 45 seconds for all classes, except for FAST which will use the set FAST course times.

FIX AND GO ON

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 243-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
