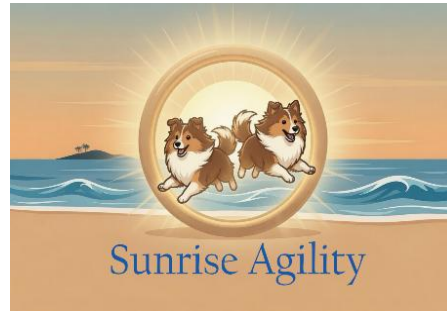




## **Trial Information!**

### Now down to the Nitty Gritty of the Trial Info

#### ITEM 1:

**Ring SET UP: Thursday at 4:00 p.m.** If you are on site and can come over to lend a hand to set up the ring we would sure appreciate it!

**Competitor Set Up will be available Friday 7:00 a.m.**

**CRATING:** Crate on either end of the ring, or out of your car.

On the far end of the arena: Please leave room for chairs and crates about 10 feet from the ring gating, (No tents). Do not pull up cars closer than 20 feet from the ring gating.

**Tents will only be allowed on the dog entry/exit side of the ring. Tents will not be allowed on the far end of the ring, i.e. opposite the entrance side. No tents close to ring gating please.**

#### ITEM 2:

Check In on Agility Gate (Thank you Roger Ly!). **The code is 0101**

#### ITEM 3:

#### ITEM 4:

**Payments due at the trial?**

- **RV payment, Zelle payment available for RV camping, see QR code on RV sign up sheet.**
- **Lunch Orders**
- **Any amount due for runs. Replacing a check.**

Come to the secretary table: Take an envelope: Write your name, and what the payment is for, on the envelope. Stick your payment in and drop it in the box. (Correct change only, overpayment is considered a donation to the club!)

Want to pay with Zelle? Sure, we'll have the QR code ready, or pay to [fsaagility.net](https://fsaagility.net) from your Zelle app. Make sure to note who the payment is from and WHAT you are paying for.

Just remember to add the \$2 Zelle fee for each Zelle transaction.

**ITEM 5** (Our favourite item! Because we have the BEST volunteers!)

For each class you work in the ring when dogs are running, you will receive a cute safety pin (on top of worker bucks and a worker raffle ticket). #### **What about RV parking?**

RV parking is first-come-first-serve on the hill.

**(Exception: Spot #1 on the hill next to the bathroom is reserved for the trial secretary).**

NOTE: All RV spots on the hill are reserved, do not park in a hook up spot if you have not received confirmation from the club that you have a hook-up spot.

**No RV parking around the arena** unless the club has assigned you a spot there.

**Will we post a running order, and a timeline?** Absolutely, it should be up by Wednesday August 12 (probably sooner if life doesn't interfere, there's a two-year old dog in the house, so you never know what may happen!). Check the trial secretary's website.
