DIRECTIONS

From I-40 East or West, the Asheville area, or points north: Take I-26 East to exit 40 (Hwy 280; also called Airport Road); go right (west) for approximately 0.6 miles. Turn left on Fanning Bridge Road at the WNC Agricultural Centersign, enter the parking lot on the right.

From the south: Take I-26 West to exit 40 (Hwy 280; also called Airport Road); go left (west) for approximately 0.7 miles (see above).

Directions to MedVet Animal Hospital:

From I-26 take exit 33 and go north on Hwy 191 (Brevard Road) just over ½ mile. Clinic will be on your left. From I-40, take exit 47 and go south on 191 for .9 miles. Clinic will be on your right.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free from internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Those helping with trailer unloading have PRIORITY crating. If you are NOT HELPING UNLOAD THE TRAILER AND SETTING UP THE RINGS, you can set up your crates AFTER 4:00 pm. Due to changes at the site, do not assume you can set up early and keep your spot. DO NOT try to set up earlier, as you may have to move, or we may move your crates for you! Remember that we have to cordon off areas for vendors and for waiting dogs at each end of the arena as well.

The building will CLOSE at 5:00 pm on Thursday and will re-open Friday morning at 6:30 am.

CHECK-IN - ONLY THE GATE-STEWARD CAN CHECK IN DOGS AT THE PHYSICAL GATE.

We will use the **Agility Gate App** for check-in. There will be no physical check in sheets. To use the app, you will need to download the free app from the Appstore or Google Play.

If you can't use the app, you can check your dog in with the gate steward when you get ready to walk. Running orders will be posted ringside and on the trial secretary's website for you to monitor your place in line. (Walk-through breaks will be marked on the running order).

From the Agility Gate app, you can:

- Check in your dog
- Mark your dog absent
- Mark Conflict
- Mark FEO
- Follow in real time where we are in the running order. On the app you can see as the gate-steward marks each dog on the line the same way you normally see it on the gate-board. The dog will have a line through the name once it steps on the line. You will see the whole gate-sheet(s) and see who is up; how many dogs until you can line up and go inside; how many dogs left to run in the height etc.
- View your course map--Open the class, click on the map icon on the lower right. The entire running order for the class is posted next to the class name. We may post updates to the trial in the messages section, (see bottom screen, so make sure to allow for notifications in your app settings). You can also set a marker dog to alert you to be ready for your run. Pick a dog ahead of yours, hold (long press) and "ok".
- You can check in after 6 a.m. each trial day.

COURSE WALK-THROUGH – Large classes will have split walk-thru. Please be sure to check the running order for your walk group.

COURSE MAPS - for each day will be posted each morning at the trial site together with the running order. Use your phone to take a photo of the course maps. **NO INDIVIDUAL MAPS WILL BE AVAILABLE ON SITE FOR COMPETITORS.**

Course Maps will also be posted on Agility Gate.

SCORING - There will be a monitor available to check your scores/placement near the scoring table. Please be respectful of others around the monitor and provide for distancing when checking the scores.

RESULTS - will be posted by the ribbons. All results will also be posted on Sunrise Agility's website at the conclusion of the trial. Individual results will be emailed to you after the trial.

REALLY IMPORTANT:

Any questions about a score must be addressed to the score keepers on the day of the trial. Ideally before the judge has certified the catalog, and BEFORE the judge starts judging the following class. (Or she won't have a chance to remember your run).

AWARDS - Ribbons will be self-service. This is how it works: After the judge has reviewed all scribe sheets and catalog pages for your class (or height group for Masters/Excellent) we will release individual printed ribbon labels. You will then be able to come to the Awards area and make your own ribbon(s) using these printed labels. We will try to have the labels out as soon as we can, but please be patient -- remember that the AKC requires extensive review of the results by judges before ribbons can be made available to competitors.

In addition to rosettes for placements and qualifying flat ribbons, we will have new title ribbons and MACH/PACH ribbons and bars. The Blue Ridge Agility Club is also happy to present anyone earning their Agility Grand Championship at our trials with a Personalized AGCh ribbon.

If you may finish your MACH, PACH or Grand Champion title over the weekend, please email the trial chair, Christie Williams, a few days before the trial starts so we can be ready for you (buufwoof@gmail.com).

Ribbons will NOT BE MAILED; you must pick them up by the conclusion of the trial or they will be recycled.

MEASURING

All dogs needing to be measured MUST be measured BEFORE their first run.

Remember: Our Volunteer Measuring Officials are VOLUNTEERS.

For this trial, we have two VMO's, one of which is also our judge, Cindy Deak. She will measure dogs before she begins judging each day.

Our second VMO is Ben Gibbs and he will be measuring during the day when he is available.

Remember: Our **Volunteer** Measuring Officials are VOLUNTEERS, they either are judging, or like Ben, are also running dogs at the trial, so please arrive in plenty of time to have your dog measured. And don't forget to thank your VMO!

Fill out your form, provided at the measuring table, before bringing your dog to be measured.

DON'T FORGET TO HAVE YOUR DOG'S REGISTRATION NUMBER AND D.O.B. HANDY.

The score table crew including the trial secretary is fully occupied entering your Qs--and possibly NQ's, but as long as we had fun right... 😊 — we just don't have time to look up your information. BREED/OBEDIENCE/RALLY CONFLICTS

We are aware that there is an All-breed show, Obedience, and Rally taking place this long weekend at the Davis Arena. Please look carefully at the Estimated Timeline and your breed/obedience/rally time slot to determine if you will have a conflict. If you can **reasonably predict** you WILL have a conflict, please let us know by filling out this online form:

Your options are:

- 1) for the first classes of the day, we will run breed/obedience/rally conflicts first.
- 2) for classes during the day where you believe you will have a conflict: let us know on the online form what height you would be able to run with (for Masters/Excellent) if you want to run first, or if needed, at the end of the heights. Or first in the class/last in the class for smaller classes.

For Master/Excellent classes, you should preferably run with an EARLIER height than a later height.

Remember you hold up the entire results for the class/jump height when you run later.

We also know that on Sat/Sun you could have unpredictable conflicts due to making group finals in breed, etc. By 7:15 each morning, YOU MUST let us know your expected conflict on the online sign-up sheet in order to be moved in the running order.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ONCE A CLASS ENDS, THAT RING WILL NOT BE HELD FOR YOUR RUN.

You must be present at some point during the running of the class to run your dog, or you will be marked absent. If it appears you will be absent, please go into the Agility Gate app and mark yourself absent; or ask a friend/other competitor to mark you absent.

We do want you to have you run, and will do everything we can to accommodate you, but you are responsible for making it happen within these parameters.
