COURSE MAPS -

for each day will be posted each morning at the trial site. The course-maps will also be posted on Agility Gate.

NO INDIVIDUAL PHYSICAL MAPS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR COMPETITORS.

CRATING

There is limited crating space in the building, share the space. There are crates set up in the building you that you may use. Please leave the crate you are borrowing clean and tidy when you leave.

CHECK-IN

Self-check-in is available via the agility gate app, OR you can check in with the gate -steward as you get ready to walk the course. The Running Order for each day will be posted near the ring.

Check in on the app is available after 6 a.m. each trial day.

If you have not used agility Gate before, make sure to download it to your phone or ipad from the Apple Store or Google Play: You need the PURPLE version.

PLEASE NOTE This app is an aid only – it is still the responsibility of the handler to make sure they are at their walkthroughs, and are at the gate, when it is their turn to run.

MEASURING

Measuring of Dogs: We do not have a VMO at the trial. The judges of record at the trial will be measuring dogs every morning before the start of the trial

If your dog needs to be measured you need to arrive before the start of the trial to have your dog measured.

The judges have very limited time between classes, so come join us to enjoy the sunrise, and delight us by helping out in the rings.

NOTE: If an AKC rep is attending the show, they are all VMO's and you can have your dog measured by the rep. (AKC reps do not announce whether they will attend a show.)

SCORING

There will be a monitor available to check your scores/placement near the scoring table.

RESULTS will be posted by the ribbons. The Move Up-sheet (CONGRATULATIONS!) will also be by the ribbons.

Check your results as soon as possible by checking the monitor. If you have a **question about your results, you need to bring it to the secretary's attention before the next class has started.**.. And preferably before the judge has reviewed the results.

RIBBONS - will be available for pick-up at the trial. All ribbons must be picked up AT the trial, none will be mailed. This is how it works: After the judge has reviewed all scribe sheets and catalog pages for your class (or height group for Masters/Excellent) we will release individual printed ribbon labels. You will then be able to come to the Awards area and make your own ribbon(s) using these printed labels. We will try to have the labels out as soon as we can, but please be patient -- remember that the AKC requires extensive review of the results by judges before ribbons can be made available to competitors.

TITLE RIBBONS - In addition to rosettes for placements and qualifying flat ribbons, we will have MACH/PACH ribbons and bars.

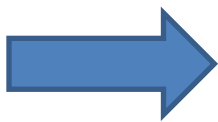
Ribbons will NOT be mailed to you after the trial; you must pick them up by Sunday or they will be recycled.
